10:00am - 11:30am Your tour begins with a visit to the Dubois County Museum, one of the largest county museums in the state of Indiana. It showcases the rich German heritage and history of Dubois County, its German immigrants, and other interesting facts.

12:00pm - 1:00pm Enjoy lunch at Legacy Steakhouse.

1:15pm -3:15 After lunch, see the workings of the Jasper City Mill, recently built to resemble the former mill that once stood along the Patoka River. Before enjoying the evening festivities, a visit to our "Faithful Watchman over Jasper", St. Joseph Church, is necessary. The beautiful 1880 Romanesque oldworld church is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and features priceless German stained-glass windows, Austrian designed mosaics, and

marble statues.







6:00PM - 8:00PM After taking in the beautiful architecture at he church its time to relax back in your room for a little before heading over to the Spirit of Jasper Train. 

Tell City Pretzels is nestled in the heart of Jasper and has been crafting irresistible pretzels since 1858. With a dedication to tradition and quality, they handcraft each pretzel with care resulting in the perfect balance of crunch and flavor. At the end of the tour, you can take your turn twisting your own pretzel. While half the group is twisting their own pretzel the other half of the group can visit The Thyen-Clark Cultural Center located just 1.5 blocks from each other.
